



The book is structured around what Blackaby calls the "Seven Realities of Experiencing God":

- 1. God is always at work around you.
- God pursues a continuing love relationship with you that is real and personal.
- God invites you to become involved with Him in His work.
- God speaks by the Holy Spirit through the Bible, prayer, circumstances, and the church to reveal Himself, His purposes, and His ways.
- God's invitation for you to work with Him always leads you to a crisis of belief that requires faith and action.
- You must make major adjustments in your life to join God in what He is doing.

David Milne* through his outreach ministry at Wollongong University occasionally has people who require short-term accommodation. (Often a couple of weeks.)


