Pray the Bible every day, with Lectio 365

FROM 24-7 PRAYER

The Lectio 365 app is a free daily devotional app from the 24-7 Prayer movement that provides guided prayer times for morning and night, inspired by practices like Lectio Divina and the Examen. It guides users through scripture, reflection, and prayer to help build a consistent prayer habit and a deeper connection with God. The app features daily devotionals, themed series, and allows users to read or listen at their own pace.

### How it Works

- Morning Devotional: Guides you to "Pause" to be still, "Reflect" on scripture, "Ask" for God's help, and "Yield" to His will.
- Night Devotional: Uses the "Examen" prayer to help you reflect on the day, rejoicing in God's goodness, repenting, and resting in His peace before sleep.
- Daily Rhythm: Designed to structure your day around prayer, with similar morning, noon, and night prayer times that were common in the early church.
